William Shakespeare's The TAMING of the SHREW


Perhaps it is an appropriate way to end THE ALLEY'S 5th SEASON of Plays Directed by Women...with this William Shakespeare classic comedy. I can be a bit old-fashioned and misogynistic, but under the deft direction of **KAY WINTER**, you'll see this script in an entirely new light.

Set in Padua this is the story of Lucentio pursuing the fair Bianca. He is soon told by her father that her bad-tempered older sister, Katherine, must marry first. And so, with the help of friends, Lucentio encourages Petruchio, who has come to Padua to find a wealthy wife, to court Katherine and free Bianca to marry. Hilarious chaos ensues.

This final Shakespeare production...as with seasons before...will be performed in the beautiful ANDERSON MUSEUM OF ART, across the street from THE ALLEY THEATRE.

Also, the winners of THE 2018 GREENBERG PLAYWRIGHT COMPETITION, along with the titles of THE ALLEY'S SIXTH SEASON will be announced during this production.



Frequently asked QUESTIONS

Why is the theatre called, THE ALLEY THEATRE, but also THE JAKE HOOVER STUDIO THEATRE?

The simple answer is: The ALLEY THEATRE is the name of the "theatre company" that produces plays, THE JAKE HOOVER STUDIO THEATRE is the space in which THE ALLEY THEATRE performs.

JAKE HOOVER is a generous and kind member of the Central Christian Church congregation who donated for the redesign of the two rooms on the bottom floor of Central, to be used as a theatre. The room that houses the performance space itself was originally intended to be both a theatre space and room for Middle School Ministries. The current stage AND electrical configuration were both original to the 1960 construction...so you could say that it has been renovated for it's primary purpose.
